Brunei Darussalam's Representative to the ACWC for Children's Rights

Dato Paduka Dr Haji Junaidi bin Haji Abd. Rahman was formerly the Permanent Secretary at the Ministry of Education in Brunei Darussalam since 2009 until 2017. His previous appointments include Acting Vice Chancellor at the Universiti Brunei Darussalam; a Dean at the Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah Insitute of Education; Universiti Brunei Darussalam; and an Acting Headmaster at the Datu Mahawangsa Lambak Primary School. His highest educational training was a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Assessment and Evaluation from University of Warwick, England. He also holds a Bachelor of Arts Education in Teaching English as a Second Language from Universiti Brunei Darussalam and a Masters of Arts in English Language Teaching from the University of Warwick, England.

Dato Paduka Dr Haji Junaidi was a country representative for the 1st Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO) Senior Officials Meeting on Education Research Network (ER-Net) in Jakarta, Indonesia. He was also a chairperson for the National English Language Taskforce, Ministry of Education and a member of several committees under the Ministry of Education such as the Arabic School Curriculum Review Committee; Primary School Continuous Assessment Review Committee; and English Language Literacy Project for Pre-School.

Mr Dato Paduka Dr Hj Junaidi had conducted portfolio assessment for the Journal of Applied Research in Education. He had also authored several publications such as Provisions for Environmental Education: The Need for Reform in Brunei Darussalam; Reflection on Writing in Portfolio Assessment: A Case Study of EF Primary Pupils in Brunei Darussalam.
