Project Description	This course will involve in-depth analysis and discussions on operational response plans and challenges faced by responders and/or emergency authorities. Participants will understand how to formulate and conduct disaster response exercises and contingency plans. Participants will also learn to appreciate (a) the tactical and operational roles of the relevant organisations, such as Government Agencies, NGOs and International Assistance bodies, during a disaster, (b) the importance of critical stress, information and media management, and (c) the UN system to coordinate international assistance in disaster and humanitarian crisis, as well as (d) the application of technologies to increase information efficiency and strengthen command and control capability.
Objective	The course aims to build and enhance the capacity and capability of CLMV countries in handling and managing crises and disasters, strengthen cooperation on disaster management and emergency response and encourage Governments to take an anticipatory approach to handle both current and future challenges.
