

Terms of Reference

Logistics and Transport Services Sectoral Working Group of the ASEAN Coordinating Committee on Services (CCS)

A. Scope of Work

1. To discuss, formulate, and implement programmes for the greater integration of the ASEAN logistics and transport sector within the scope of the CCS through the liberalisation, facilitation, and cooperation programmes.
2. To discuss, formulate, and implement programmes for the implementation of the Roadmap for the Integration of Logistics Services within the scope of the CCS.
3. To discuss, plan, and implement relevant economic cooperation activities in the logistics and transport sector, within the scope of the CCS.
4. To discuss and implement programmes for greater public-private sector cooperation on logistics and transport integration, within the scope of the CCS.
5. To undertake other tasks as assigned by the CCS.

B. Membership

6. The Sectoral Working Group shall comprise representatives from ASEAN Member States with mandate to coordinate the implementation of all relevant tasks as specified in section A above.

C. Chairmanship and Secretary Post

7. The Chairperson of the Sectoral Working Group shall be on a 2 (two) year [period from January to December alphabetically rotational basis](#).
