

Ministerial Regulation
Fees Collected under the Multimodal Transport Law
B.E.2550 (2007)

By virtue of Section 6 of the Multimodal Act, B.E.2548 (2005), the Minister of Transport hereby issues a ministerial regulation as follows:

The fees collected under the Multimodal Transport Law shall be imposed as follows:

- (1) Registration certificate of multimodal transport operator
- (2) Certificate of entry into official record
- (3) Certificate of agency
- (4) Permit for setting up a branch office of the multimodal transport operator registered under Section 39 (1)
- (5) Substitute of:
 - (a) registration certificate of multimodal transport operator
 - (b) certificate of entry into official record
 - (c) certificate of agency
- (6) Application for registration
- (7) Application for entry into official record
- (8) Application for appointment of agent
- (9) Application for renewal of certificate
- (10) Application for setting up a branch office of the multimodal transport operator registered under Section 39 (1)
- (11) Other applications

Note :- The reason behind the issuance of this Ministerial Regulation comes from Section 6 of the Multimodal Transport Act, B.E.2548 (2005) which empowers the Minister of Transport to issue a ministerial regulation to impose the fees which must not exceed the rates appeared in the attachment of the Act.
