Objective	This project aims to simplify business registration processes in Cambodia, Lao PDR and Myanmar through assisting governments to simplify the procedures, enhance coordination between relevant authorities and modernise their registration regimes by implementing electronic online registry systems based on good regulatory practices.
Implementation Status	Assessment on Myanmar and Lao PDR was completed in March 2018 and July 2018, respectively. Assessment on Cambodia is planned for 26-30 November 2018.
