

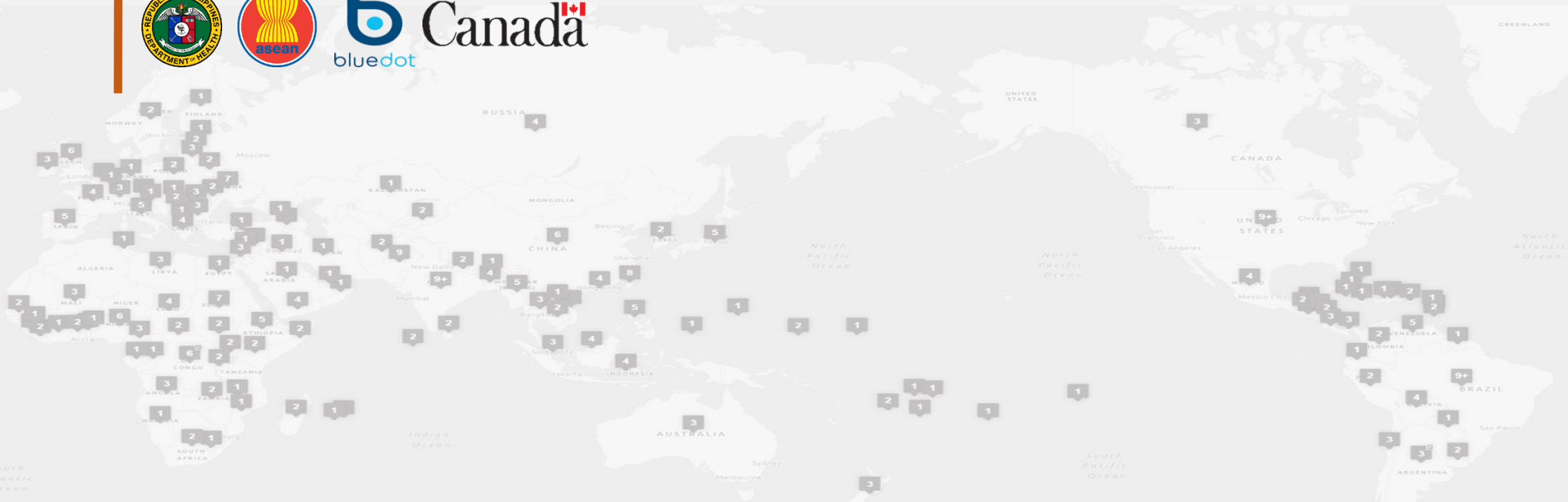

## COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 54.7 million cases and more than 1.32 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- The 37th ASEAN Summit and related Summit wrapped up on Sunday (November 15) afternoon with the adoption of the ASEAN Comprehensive Recovery Framework among major outcomes. Leaders from ASEAN countries, the Republic of Korea (RoK), Japan and China shared the view on the need to enhance their cooperation in the COVID-19 fight and economic recovery. During the Summit, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi also announced USD 1 million aid to ASEAN Covid-19 Response Fund, Leaders from ASEAN and India highlighted the significant importance of the ASEAN-India strategic partnership for peace, stability, development and prosperity in the Indo-Pacific region. Regarding regional and international situation, the two sides pledged to continue working together to deal with traditional and non-traditional challenges. In this summit, the Republic of Korea (RoK) leader expressed his hope that essential business travel will expand further to the extent that it does not undermine disease control efforts as COVID-19 persists longer than anticipated. He suggested the countries upgrade cooperation in the area of public health and work towards the development and equitable supply of vaccines and treatments, saying it is a must to establish a timely and transparent coordination mechanism to prepare against new infectious diseases which can strike at any time. Based on collaboration between Japan, China and the RoK, a contribution of USD300,000 has been made from the ASEAN Plus Three Cooperation Fund to the ASEAN COVID-19 Response Fund. The Chinese leader expressed his belief that the countries could work together to mitigate the pandemic and reopen the economy, thus opening up a bright prospect of peace, development and prosperity for the region.
- Indonesia has entered the monitoring stage of a phase three clinical trial for the Chinese-developed vaccine Sinovac. In Indonesia, the trial is being conducted in Bandung and participated in by 1,620 volunteers of multiple ethnicities across Indonesia. Some of the volunteers are of European descent. The Bio Farma Director hoped that the clinical trial team would finish the monitoring phase by May 2021. The monitoring result will be delivered to the Indonesia Food and Drug Monitoring Agency (BPOM) through an interim report in early January next year to obtain Emergency Use Authorization (EUA). The report itself will consist of evidence on efficacy, immunogenicity and safety. He added that the phase three clinical trial was part of global multicenter clinical trials conducted by four nations, namely Brazil, Chile, Indonesia and Turkey, and involving over 20,000 volunteers. He explained that the clinical trials were being conducted in different countries to see the vaccine's efficacy in various races worldwide. Indonesia reported 4,106 new COVID-19 infections on Sunday (November 15), taking the total number of cases to 467,113. On Friday (November 13), Indonesia said it has sought emergency authorization to start a mass vaccination campaign by the end of the year. Indonesia's President said that plans were already advanced to distribute the vaccine across the entire country. If approval is granted by the country's food and drug agency, known by its Indonesian acronym BPOM, it will mean Indonesia - with 270 million people, the world's fourth most populous country - will be among the first in the world to roll out a coronavirus vaccine.

- COVID-19 positive cases in Mandalay (Myanmar) have increased post-election with 240 new cases within 4 days after November 8. The region reported between 30 to 80 new cases daily since end of October, wherein the highest number of cases were reported in Chan Aye Tharzan, Amarapura, and Maha Aung Myay townships. Residents from these townships have been placed under stay-at-home orders. Recently, cases have spiked since election which urge the government to open the newest quarantine center in Pyigyitagun township. On November 15, Myanmar reported 983 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the country's total cases to 68,994, the fourth most affected country in the ASEAN region.
- Singapore's Prime Minister on Saturday (November 14) called on Australia and New Zealand to work with the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) to ease border restrictions, saying this will facilitate the resumption of economic activity as the COVID-19 pandemic stabilizes. Singapore has unilaterally opened its borders to travellers from Vietnam, Brunei, New Zealand and Australia. Unlike the fast or green lane arrangements, this includes all forms of short-term travel, including for leisure. For Australia and New Zealand, however, their governments have not lifted border restrictions, advising their residents not to travel abroad. Those who need to travel must apply for an exemption.
- South Korea reported more than 200 new coronavirus cases for the third consecutive day on Monday (November 16), as the government mulls tightening social distancing to curb persistent outbreaks from offices, medical facilities and small gatherings. The Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency (KDCA) posted 223 cases as of midnight on Sunday (November 15), marking the ninth straight day of triple-digit increases and the highest since early September. Health authorities warned of re-strengthening distancing curbs which were relaxed about a month ago to the lowest levels, as small cluster infections continue to break out while the pandemic is raging around the globe. Tighter curbs would ban public gatherings of 100 people or more, limit religious services and audiences at sporting events to 30% of capacity, and require high-risk facilities including clubs and karaoke bars to widen distance among guests. Of the new cases, 193 were locally transmitted and 30 imported, according to the KDCA. More than 66 per cent of the domestic infections were from the densely populated greater Seoul area, where outbreaks continue to emerge from nursing homes, medical facilities and small businesses.

### Cases and Deaths as of 16 November 2020

- As of November 16 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **54,817,324** confirmed cases, including **1,325,042** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **2.42**.
- In **China**, there were **92,445** confirmed cases with **4,749** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (108) and Taiwan (7). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (5,459), Macau (46), and Taiwan (602).
- 1,055,110 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **25,055 deaths**.

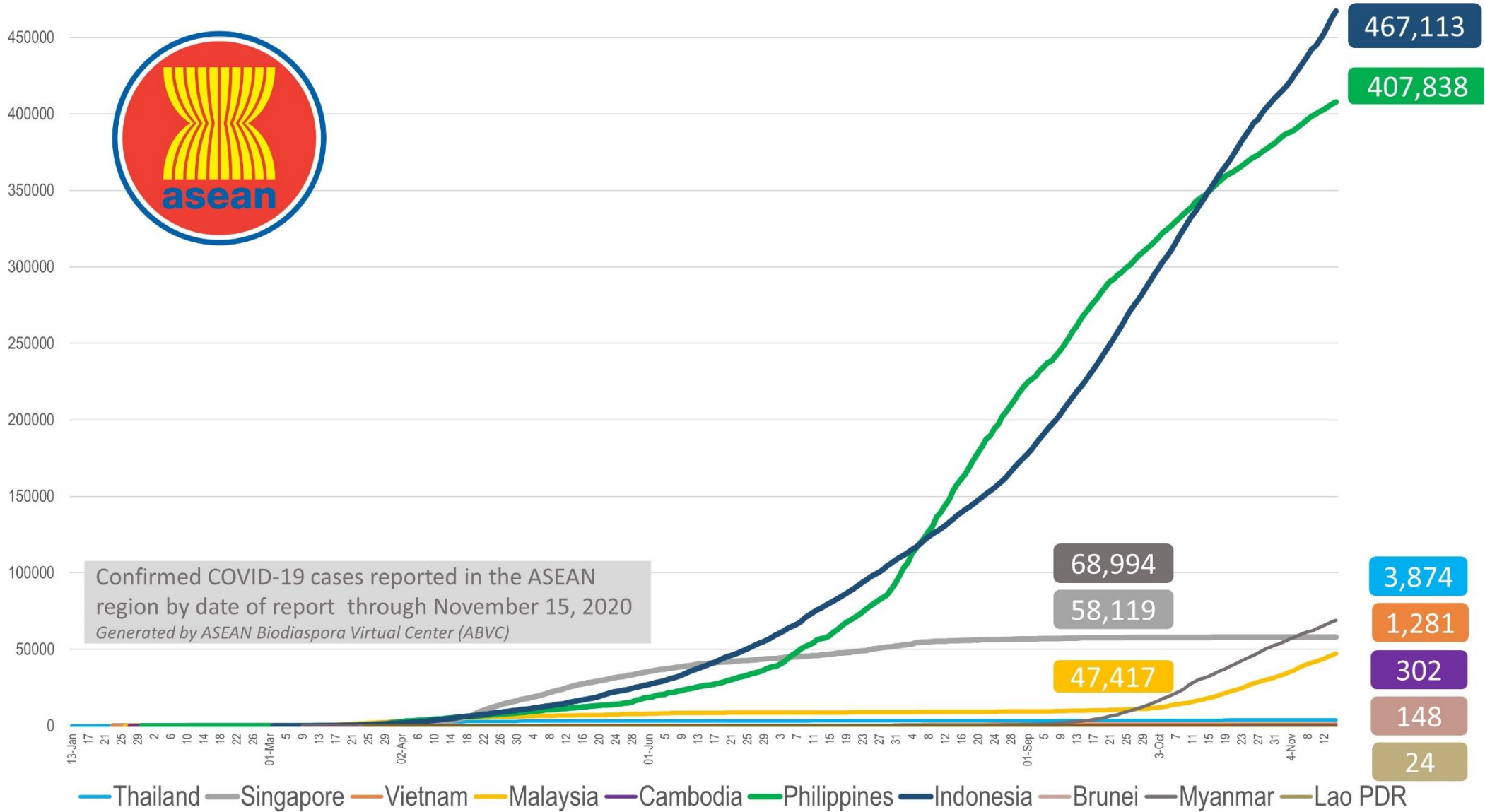
