## COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 15.5 million cases and over 632,000 deaths attributed to COVID-19. In the past seven days, there have been over 1.6 million cases reported globally. In Europe, nearly 3 million cases have been reported since the beginning of the outbreak while in Latin America there have been over 4 million cases reported. In the United States, cases continue to rise. Over the past two weeks, the United States has reported over 900,000 new cases, more than what the country reported for the entire month of June (~875,000). In addition, over the past few days, several countries have reported record-high single-day increases in new infections including Australia, Austria, Argentina, Japan and Kenya.
- Brunei reported no new cases of COVID-19 with the national tally of cases standing at 141 as of July 15. Today marks the 78th consecutive day without new cases since May 7. In addition, Brunei government announces further easing of COVID-19 restrictions starting July 27. Mass gathering will be permitted but is limited to not more than 100 people only. Arcade and Playground (indoor and outdoor) will be permitted to operate at 30% capacity of their normal capacity at any one time. Other places of worship besides mosque and surau will be permitted to operate to their normal capacity starting August 3. In addition, Brunei has appointed a committee to discuss border crossing issues under the current Covid-19 pandemic to help create a safe and guided policy. According to the authority on July 23, the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) has set up its own online platform where the public can apply to enter or exit the country.
- Laos reported no new cases of COVID-19 with the national tally of cases standing at 19 as of July 15. Today marks the 103<sup>rd</sup> consecutive day without new cases since April 12.
- Cambodia's Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (MEYS) has released a list of schools that will lead the country's education system reopening, expected to start next month. Schools in Cambodia have been closed since March 16 as part of the country's successful attempt to prevent community transmission of the SARS-CoV-2 virus. Those included in the first of a three-phase planned opening include 20 of the most private institutions in Phnom Penh, Siem Reap, and Battambang.
- With the COVID-19 pandemic requiring an unprecedented scale of laboratory testing, Indonesia continues to face disparities in testing between regions. The country is now operating 269 laboratories to run polymerase chain reaction (PCR) tests for diagnoses. However, the largest PCR testing lab in Papua has announced that it will stop accepting new samples for COVID-19 testing on July 25 because of a lack of reagent and single-use equipment. The lab at the Papuan Health Research and Development Agency (Balitbangkes) accounts for more than half of the province's testing capacity under normal circumstances. Typically, the Balitbangkes lab, which is managed by the Health Ministry, receives 400 to 500 samples a day. As of July 23, the Health Ministry announced 1,906 new confirmed COVID-19 cases bringing the total number of infections nationwide to 93,657.
- Even when it was in the grip of COVID-19 in March, Malaysia never made the wearing of face masks mandatory. Defense Minister said this was to avoid placing financial stress on the country's poor, given that face masks should be changed at least once a day. Today (July 24), Defence Minister announced

that face masks will now become mandatory while on public transport or in crowded public spaces, with heavy fines levied at those who do not comply. From August 1, anyone found not wearing a mask where one is required by law, can be fined USD 235. He said that the decision to make face masks mandatory is the result of a Health Ministry report which shows that the public has become lax with social distancing, particularly on public transport and in other crowded areas.

- Vietnam's Prime Minister has issued a directive to ban the country's wildlife trade with immediate effect in order to reduce the risk of new pandemics. The directive bans imports of live wild animals and wildlife products, eliminates wildlife markets, and enforces prohibitions on illegal hunting and trading of wild animals, including online sales, according to the statement issued late on Thursday (July 23).

#### Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- Singapore: Singapore's Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) said on Thursday (July 23), that Singapore will "work closely" with Japan to make progress on resuming essential travel between the two countries. This comes a day after Japan announced that it would proceed with discussions on the resumption of essential travel with 12 places, including Singapore.
- Thailand: A number of additional categories of foreigners will be able to apply to re-enter the Kingdom. These include migrant workers from Cambodia, Laos and Myanmar, Elite Visa holders, medical tourists, film crew, convention exhibitors and select business visitors. Anyone that doesn't fall into one of those groups will remain excluded from the country as the borders remain shut to almost all other international arrivals. All arrivals will still have to carry out the mandatory 14-day state quarantine. However, according to the Thailand's COVID-19 task force, the definite date has not been decided yet but interested parties may contact the Thai Embassy.

#### Cases and Deaths as of 24 July 2020

- As of July 24 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **15,290,683** confirmed cases, including **633,569** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Ratio (CFR)\* is **4.14**
- In **China**, there were **86,480** confirmed cases with **4,656** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (15) and Taiwan (7). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (2,250), Macau (46), and Taiwan (445).
- **230,367 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **6,664 deaths**.

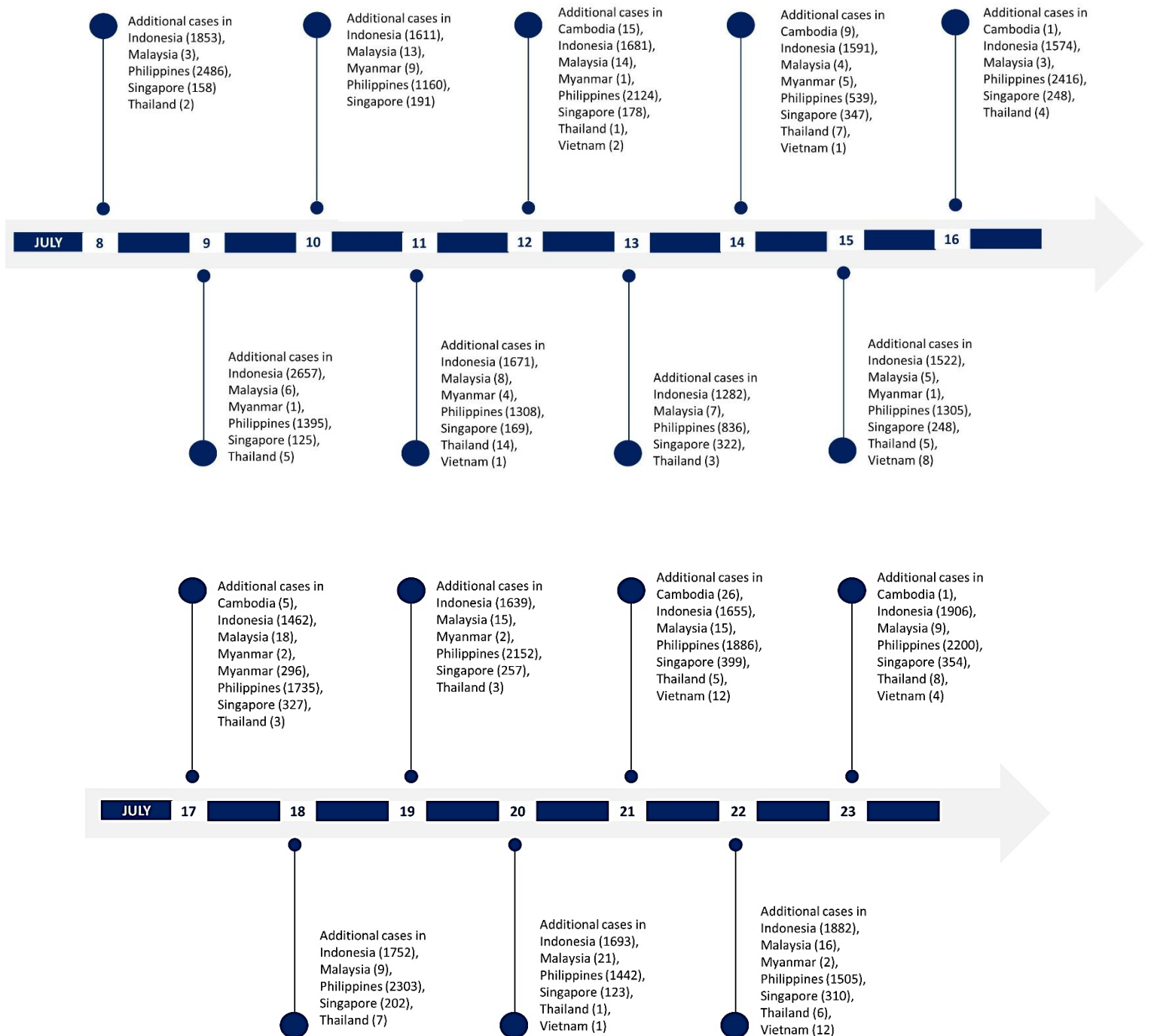

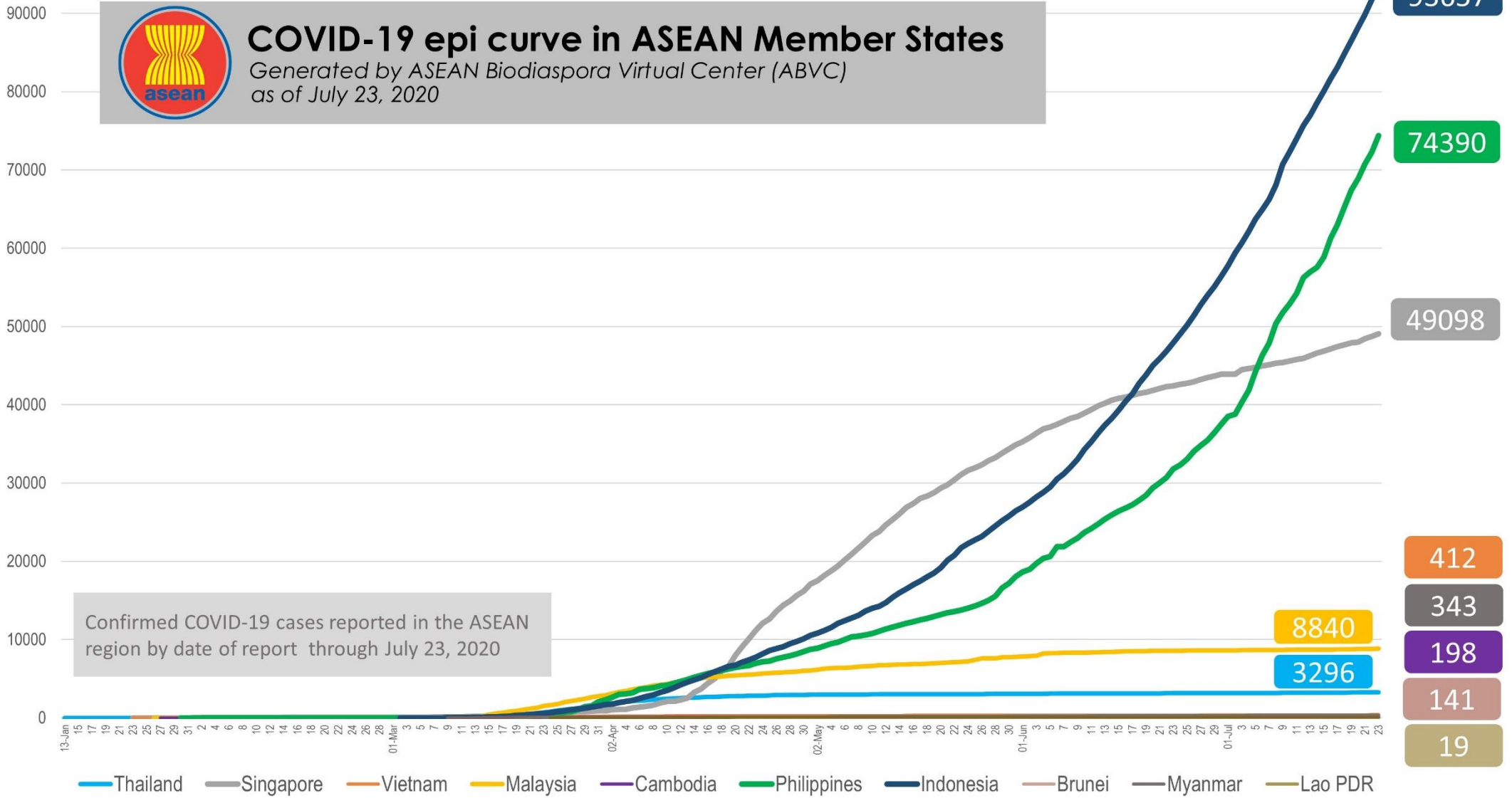
