Participants will also be introduced to the roles and functions of the different Government authorities in Singapore handling food security and safety issues.
Objective	The project aims to help build and enhance the capacity and capability of LM countries to better manage issues of food security and food safety.
Implementation Status	The trainings were conducted on 11-15 June 2018 and 9-13 July 2018.
