Project Description	This course provides an overview of Singapore's philosophy towards corruption control and the anti-corruption strategies implemented. The course will focus on the frameworks used to combat corruption, including the auditing process and the processes used to grow and maintain a culture of integrity among public officers and citizens. Participants will gain insights on the principles underlying governance within the Singapore Public Service, the macro strategies used in corruption control in Singapore; the role of Singapore's Corrupt Practices Investigation Bureau (CPIB) and its mandate in Singapore's anti-corruption strategy and how to apply the 3E approach in developing and enforcing anti-corruption strategies within their own national contexts.
Objective	This course aims to help build the strategic leadership and administrative capability of CLMV countries in addressing the impact of technology developments and advancements. It also aims to encourage Governments to take an active and anticipatory approach to governance so as to meet both current and future challenges.
Implementation Status	The trainings are going to be conducted on August 2018 and January 2019.
