<b>Brunei Darussalam</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Similar treatment for locals and foreigners</li> <li>• Temporary registration: up to one year (renewable)</li> <li>• Full registration 12 months (renewable)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Licensing requires registration</li> <li>• Requires 30 CME points &amp; medical fitness</li> </ul>
<b>Cambodia</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Current system: Registration: lifelong</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hold qualification for medical profession recognized by the MoH</li> <li>• Successfully completed national exit exam;</li> <li>• Never been convicted of any crimes in Cambodia or any other countries</li> <li>• Maintained the required norms of competence for health professional practice</li> <li>• Demonstrate that they have either recently qualified or have recent experience of lawfully practicing the profession</li> <li>• Has no mental or physical condition that may impact on their ability to practice</li> <li>• Local-trained specialist student or internship student must be certified by their education institutions</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Licensing: 3 years (renewable)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has registered with Medical Council of Cambodia</li> <li>• International trained-doctor must have valid registration/license to practice, certified copy of current registration/licensing issued by the medical council of country where he/she is practicing medicine,</li> <li>• Letter of good standing or Certificate of Professional Status from the medical council or relevant authority of the country of his/her practicing medicine;</li> <li>• International Medical Graduate: Certification letter from supervisor (Full registration doctor)</li> </ul>

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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CPD points are required for re-licensing (60 CPD Points for 3 years, at least 15 CDP Points each year).</li> </ul>
<b>Indonesia</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Certification, registration, licensing: 5 years (renewable)</li> <li>• Licensing granted for 3 places</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 50 CPD points required per year or examination, and medical fitness</li> </ul>
<b>Lao PDR</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Initial license: 2 years (for new graduates)</li> <li>• Full license: 5 years <i>(Regulation is being developed)</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Initial license: National examination for new graduates Full license: Renewable every 5 years subject to requirement of the Healthcare Professional Council <i>(Regulation is being developed)</i></li> </ul>
<b>Malaysia</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full Registration</li> <li>• Annual Practicing Certificate</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As per Amended Medical Act 2012</li> <li>• 20 CPD Points required for annual practicing certificate</li> <li>• Indemnity insurance</li> </ul>
<b>Myanmar</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Registration: lifelong</li> <li>• Licensing for practice: valid for 3 years (renewable)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Graduated from recognised universities with completion of internship</li> <li>• Requires evaluation for foreign-graduated locals</li> <li>• Plan to include CPD for renewal</li> </ul>
<b>Philippines</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full Registration: permanent</li> <li>• License: 3 years (renewable)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Graduated from recognised medical school and completed 1year internship</li> <li>• Passed the physician licensure exam for registration to the profession</li> <li>• CPD of 45 credit units required for renewal of license every 3 years</li> </ul>
<b>Singapore</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provisional Registration – Postgraduate year 1</li> <li>• Conditional Registration – From postgraduate year 2 onwards</li> <li>• Full registration – From postgraduate year 2 onwards</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Licensing requirements of Country of Origin may be required.</li> </ul> <p>Refer to <a href="#">Singapore Medical Council website</a> for details</p>
<b>Thailand</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Licensing and registration: lifelong</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Similar requirement for local and foreign:</li> </ul>

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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Graduated from the recognised universities</li><li>• Pass licensing examination</li><li>• Maintenance of license/registration: no malpractice and CPD is encouraged</li></ul>
<b>Vietnam</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Full Licensing: lifelong</li><li>• Registration: lifelong</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Graduated from recognised medical schools</li><li>• 18 months practice in hospital</li><li>• 48 hours of CME for at least 2 years</li></ul>

\*Note: Licensing refers to permit to practise
