
MAKING INFORMATION AVAILABLE ONLINE

Study abroad can open up opportunities for students to broaden their perspectives, learn about different cultures, understand more about their own, and develop personal networks, to name a few.


Study abroad can also promote their employability in the global market by helping them acquire competencies to become an active part of the global community.


Online information is the first source for exploring study #2 **>** abroad options
