

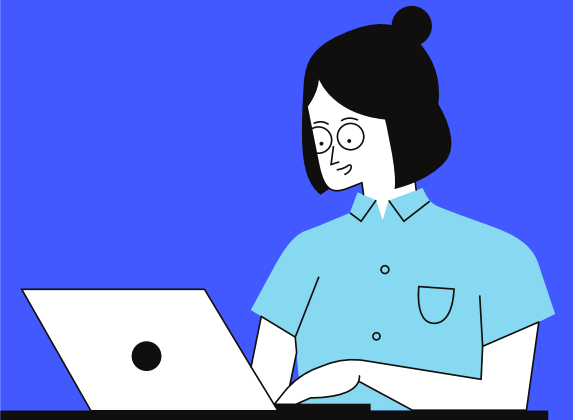

WHY IS STUDENT MOBILITY IMPORTANT? ✕

In this globalized world, increasing numbers of students are studying across borders. **Promoting student mobility is important, because...**

#1 STUDENT

Study abroad can open up opportunities for students to broaden their perspectives, learn about different cultures, understand more about their own, and develop personal networks, to name a few.

Study abroad can also promote their employability in the global market by helping them acquire competencies to become an active part of the global community.

#2 UNIVERSITIES

Universities can create a better educational environment to prepare students with skills and attitudes necessary in this diverse society.

#3 GOVERNMENTS

It contributes to a country's efforts to achieve economic development and harmonious relationships with other countries based on mutual understanding.

License, external evaluation result

2-2 Academic Calendar

Enrollment period, yearly schedule, national holidays

2-3 Degree Programmes

Programmes / Programmes offered in English

2-4 Tuition and Other Fees

2-5 Faculty Members (Teachers)

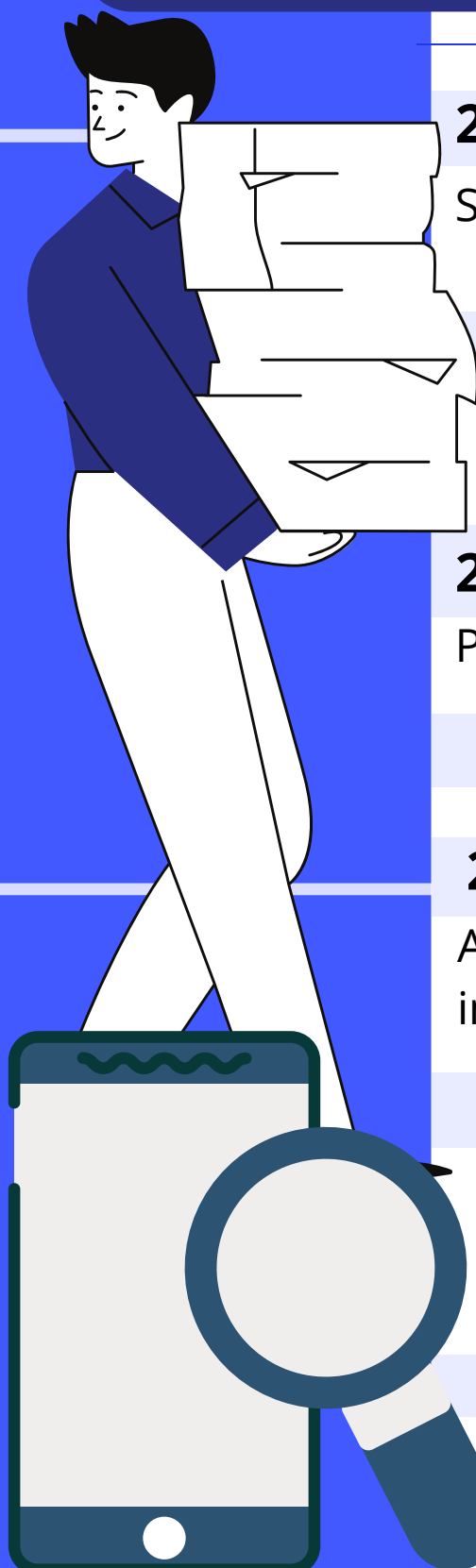
Area of research, profile, contact information, research introduction of labs

2-6 Course List

Including language of instruction, syllabus, credits, lecture style (in-person / online), student workload, expected learning outcomes, etc.

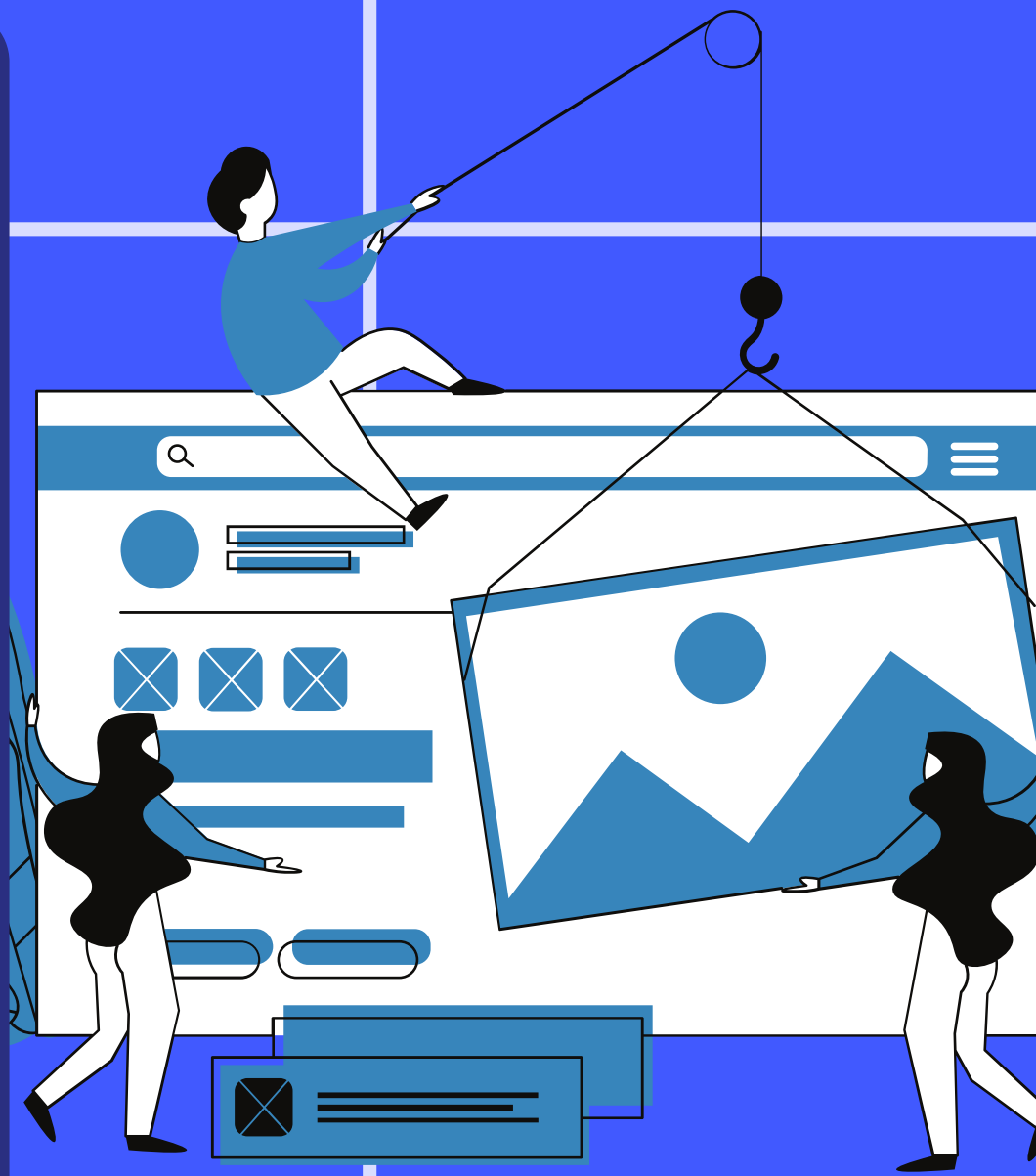
Academic requirements, language requirements

4-1 Impressions and Views of the Students

Students stories, voices of students, student life cycle (yearly / weekly / daily timetable)

4-2 Campus Environment and Student Facilities

Parking, sports facilities, library, IT facilities and resources, cafeterias, shops

4-3 Cost of Living

Estimated cost of housing, food, and transportation

4-4 Housing Options

Dormitory, apartment rental

4-5 Student Financial Aid

Scholarships, on-campus jobs

4-6 Student Support

Student health center, language support, counselling, welfare, insurance, etc.

4-7 International Opportunities

Study abroad programs (contents, destination, duration), partner universities, application (procedure, schedule, requirements), participation fees, internship, service learning, cultural experience

4-8 Safety

Safety guidelines, emergency contact information

Extracurricular Activities **OPTIONAL**

Festivals, events, sports and cultural clubs (associations)

OPTIONAL Career Prospects

Careers of the graduates, statistical information, career support

5-2 Other International Short-term Programmes

Eligibility, program contents, application procedure & schedules, fees, expected outcomes, student workload, voice of students, etc.
