ROADMAP ON THE ASEAN HIGHER EDUCATION SPACE 2025

Introduction

The **Kuala Lumpur Declaration on Higher Education** was adopted by the 27th ASEAN Summit in 2015. The Declaration initiated the work of SOM-ED towards the development of an ASEAN Higher Education Space, by acknowledging 'higher education as one of the catalysts in accelerating ASEAN's economic, political and sociocultural development agenda' and the need to "embrace [the] diversity and solidarity of the ASEAN Community through enhanced intra-ASEAN mobility of students and scholars." The **Master Plan on ASEAN Connectivity (MPAC) 2025**, which focuses on physical, institutional and people-to-people linkages, also contains an explicit strategic objective to increase the number of intra-ASEAN international students by 2025.

Coupled with the second **ASEAN Work Plan on Education 2016 - 2020**, this was envisaged as being achieved through augmenting the quality of ASEAN higher education provision, enabling greater comparability and recognition of qualifications through harmonisation, facilitating the transfer of credits for student mobility periods, and catalysing internationalisation through a critical mass of mobility under an ASEAN Branded Scholarship.

There have been significant developments and outcomes achieved in this body of work since the adoption of the Kuala Lumpur Declaration. The third **ASEAN Work Plan on Education 2021 – 2025**, adopted by the ASEAN Education Ministers Meeting (ASED) on May 31st 2021, will see the work in this sphere of the ASEAN Socio-cultural Community Blueprint consolidated, contributing to the attainment of the ASEAN Vision 2025 thus enhancing the quality, competitiveness, and internationalisation of its higher education institutions.

The higher education components of the new ASEAN Work Plan on Education 2021 – 2025 carry forward the undertakings of the Kuala Lumpur Declaration and are delineated under Outcome 3 of 'Enhanced regional capacity in higher education as part of lifelong learning provision, including the harmonisation of ASEAN higher education and the following outputs.' The scope of work to deliver greater harmonisation and internationalisation of ASEAN higher education is found under Output 3.2. 'Sustained and strengthened ASEAN capacity in higher education harmonisation through strategies, mechanisms and scholarship provision.'

The key activities operationalising the outputs of the Work Plan have been allocated to key regional higher education stakeholders which include the membership of the newly formed **ASEAN Working Group on Higher Education Mobility 2025** (hereinafter referred to as 'Working Group'), chaired by the Education Youth and Sports Division (EYSD) of the ASEAN Secretariat, the ASEAN Foundation, with the technical and operational advisory of the EU Support to Higher Education in the ASEAN Region (SHARE) Programme for the duration of the SHARE Programme. Within the remit of the Working Group is the formulation and proposal of this Roadmap to realise and implement the **ASEAN Higher Education Space¹** for greater people-to-people connectivity and knowledge transfer across ASEAN, in the framework of the ASEAN Education Work Plan 2021 - 2025. This Roadmap will deliver the mandates and commitments of ASEAN related to boosting intra-ASEAN student mobility by 2025, including the design, ownership, and operationalisation of an **ASEAN Branded Scholarship**.

This is in line with the **Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG4)** which aims to "Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all." In addition, it seeks to address SDG Target 4.b "By 2020, substantially expand globally the number of scholarships available to developing countries, (...), for enrolment in higher education, including vocational training and information and communications technology, technical, engineering and scientific programs, in developed countries and other developing countries." The initiative of the Working Group to realise an ASEAN Branded Scholarship in the framework of an ASEAN Higher Education Space by 2025, demonstrates the commitment of the ASEAN Member States (AMS) to Sustainable Development Goal Target 4.b.

The initiatives and components that lead towards the development of an ASEAN Higher Education Space, including quality assurance, higher education mobility², and recognition of higher education qualifications, are aligned with the ASEAN Declaration on Human Resource Development in the Changing World of Work, the ASEAN Comprehensive Recovery Framework, the ASEAN Digital Masterplan 2025, and the ongoing initiative for a Declaration on Digital Transformation of Education Systems in ASEAN. The roadmap and its implementation plan take a whole of ASEAN Community approach in the development of an ASEAN Higher Education Space and contributes to improved inclusiveness in higher education, augmented employability and competitiveness, and the acquisition of demand driven competencies and qualifications. Furthermore, it contributes to the ASEAN Community Vision 2025 and strengthening of future resilience through enhanced people to people connectivity, enhanced access and recognition of higher education in the ASEAN region.

This Roadmap is developed against the backdrop of the changing context of higher education globally and the disruption to student mobility wrought by the COVID-19 pandemic. Cognisant of this new reality, the Roadmap proposes adaptive and sustainable approaches to ASEAN higher education harmonisation strategies and internationalisation methodologies. This includes augmenting access and inclusion to internationalised higher education provision through digital transformation.

Objectives of the Roadmap

In developing a roadmap aimed at fully implementing initiatives towards an ASEAN Higher Education Space and the management of an ASEAN Branded Scholarship by 2025, the Roadmap will have the following objectives:

- 1. Consolidate the vision and commitments set out in the Kuala Lumpur Declaration on Higher Education:
- 2. Formulate and propose an ASEAN Declaration and Vision on the ASEAN Higher Education Space as a high-level commitment to the objectives of the Working Group;
- 3. Determine key milestones in the design, development and implementation of the Working Group's activities;
- 4. Contribute to the underlying visions of ASEAN 2025 and a post-2025 agenda as well as the sustainability and resilience of an ASEAN Higher Education Space;
- 5. Provide strategic guidance to the Senior Officials Meeting on Education (SOM-ED) on the implementation of the relevant activities ASEAN Work Plan on Education 2021 2025 in accordance with their respective mandates;
- 6. Identify, agree, and implement the procedure, timeline, and capacity building required to transfer of ownership of assets and action lines from the SHARE Programme to the ASEAN nominated entity/entities, prior to the SHARE Programme's conclusion at the end of 2022, to sustainably lead the initiative to 2025 and beyond;

- 7. Identify, develop and implement continued Technical Assistance and Capacity Building Activities required for the Working Group and ASEAN Member States
- 8. Establish programme areas for the following components, within the implementation plan:
 - a. The Digital Transformation of ASEAN Higher Education
 - Virtual Exchange / Collaborative Online International Education (COIL)
 - Digital Credentials / Digitalised Credit Transfer System
 - b. Communities of Practice of ASEAN Higher Education Practitioners / Alumni
 - c. Support for Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, and Vietnam on student mobility
 - d. Graduate Employability in ASEAN

Key Principles of the Roadmap

In implementing the Roadmap aimed at realising an initiative towards an ASEAN Higher Education Space and the management of an ASEAN Branded Scholarship by 2025, the Working Group will observe the following key principles.

Measurable: Agreed targets to be achieved with clear timelines and key performance indicators to track progress;

Impactful: Programmes are mutually reinforcing and will be delivered in a coherent manner, focus on strategies and activities with most impact for the ASEAN higher education systems and students, supported by strong sustainability mechanisms at regional and national levels;

Participatory: Fostering voluntary collaboration amongst all stakeholders to support holistic approaches and outcomes; and acknowledging students/ learners, higher education practitioners, and stakeholders as partners and agents of their own learning and capacity development; and take due consideration the national regulations and different contexts of ASEAN Member States.

Complementary and Pragmatic: Ensuring the alignment of the eventual intra-ASEAN initiative with ASEAN mandates, commitments, and other initiatives including those of the SHARE Programme; the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), especially Goal 4, as well as stakeholders' interests;

Equitable, Diverse and Inclusive: Ensuring all target groups, genders are facilitated and supported to have equal access to development opportunities so as to promote equal opportunities for all in ASEAN higher education;

Sustainable: Ensuring that strong sustainability mechanisms (financial and human resources) are in place to implement programmes and inform developments in the region.

Framework of the Roadmap

The following table sets out the vision and outcomes to be achieved by the Working Group, in the framework of the ASEAN Education Work Plan 2021 – 2025

Strategies: Each key area will focus on three strategies, as needed:

- 1. **Capacity Building** for the working group, AMS and relevant organizations, and higher education institutions in relation to each key area
- 2. Technical Assistance in cases there is a need for external inputs on relevant matters within the key area
- **3. Policy Dialogues** to promote, discuss and reach consensus among AMS on key directions, policies, guidelines, mechanisms and tools

Review and Reporting of the Roadmap Implementation

 Multi-stakeholder meetings involving the permanent and non-permanent members of the Working Group will be conducted to exchange information on progress of the implementation of this Roadmap.

- Permanent and non-permanent members will also monitor progress of their respective complementary initiatives and report these to the meetings of the Working Group
- Result-based key performance indicators (KPIs) will be developed for this Roadmap.
- This Roadmap shall be regularly reviewed to ensure relevance and coherence with regional developments of ASEAN.
- Outcomes and results of this Roadmap's implementation plan will be evaluated in 2025 with a view of continuing efforts on the development and enhancement of an ASEAN Higher Education Space and ASEAN Branded Scholarship beyond 2025
