ANNEX 1

SCHEDULE OF COMMITMENTS FOR THE TEMPORARY ENTRY OR TEMPORARY STAY OF NATURAL PERSONS

CAMBODIA

- This Schedule sets out the commitments of Cambodia and the general conditions and limitations governing those commitments in accordance with Article 6 (Schedules of Commitments for the Temporary Entry and Temporary Stay of Natural Persons) of the MNP Agreement in relation to the temporary entry and temporary stay of a natural person of another Member State, which apply only in relation to the categories of natural persons set out in this Schedule.
- A natural person of a Member State shall be granted temporary entry or temporary stay in Cambodia in accordance with paragraph 1 of Article 4 (Grant of Temporary Entry or Temporary Stay) of the MNP Agreement.
- 3. For greater certainty, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 4 (Grant of Temporary Entry or Temporary Stay) of the MNP Agreement, Cambodia may deny temporary entry or temporary stay to natural persons of another Member State who do not comply with paragraphs 1(a) and 1(b) of Article 4 (Grant of Temporary Entry or Temporary Stay) of the MNP Agreement.
- 4. References to Central Product Classification (CPC) in this Schedule refer to the CPC codes as used in the Provisional Central Product Classification (Statistical Papers Series M No.77, Department of International Economic and Social Affairs, Statistical Office of the United Nations, New York, 1991).
- 5. The use of (**) against individual CPC codes indicates that the specific commitments for that code shall not extend to total range of services covered under that code.
- 6. Section I refers to horizontal commitments and Section II refers to sector specific commitments. An empty (blank) conditions and limitations in Section II means that the general conditions and limitations of the horizontal section, including the length of stay, shall apply and could be read as "unbound, except as indicated in Section I".
- 7. The Schedules of other Member States shall not be used to interpret Cambodia's commitments or obligations under the MNP Agreement.

Additional Notes for Cambodia

- 8. Cambodia reserves the right to adopt or maintain any measures in relation to National Treatment applicable to subsidies, including for Research and development services.
- For greater certainty, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 2 (Scope) of the MNP Agreement, Cambodia reserves the right to adopt or maintain any measures in respect of requirements of requisite visa and the conditions attached to temporary entry and temporary stay

Natural persons working in an executive or managerial position, receiving remuneration from a juridical person, as defined below, who are responsible for the setting up, in Cambodia, of a commercial presence of a service provider of a Member State, that will support employment of persons described in categories (i), (ii), and (iii) of the Intra-Corporate Transferees definition.

The natural persons responsible for setting up of a commercial establishment are not subject to a maximum duration of stay.

C. Intra-Corporate Transferee

Natural persons who have been employed by a juridical person of another Member State for a period of not less than one year and who seek temporary entry to provide services through a branch, subsidiary, or affiliate in Cambodia and who are:

(i) **Executives**: without requiring compliance with labour market tests, natural persons within an

organisation who primarily direct the management of the organisation, exercise wide latitude in decision-making, and receive only general supervision or direction from higher-level executives, the board of directors, or shareholders of the business. Executives would not directly perform tasks related to the actual supply of a service or services of the organisation;

- (ii) Managers: without requiring compliance with labour market tests, natural persons employed by a juridical person and who possess knowledge at an advanced level of expertise or proprietary knowledge of a juridical person's product, service. research, equipment, techniques, or management, and who primarily direct the organisation or a department of the organisation; supervise and control the work of other supervisory, professional or managerial employees; have the authority to hire and fire recommend hiring, firing or other personnel actions; and exercise discretionary authority over day-today operations. They do not include first-line supervisors, unless the employees supervised professionals, nor do they include employees who primarily perform tasks necessary for the supply of the service; or
- (iii) **Specialists**: natural persons within an organisation who possess knowledge at an advanced level of continued expertise and who possess proprietary knowledge of the organisation's services, research equipment, techniques, or management.

D. Contractual Service Suppliers

Contractual Service Supplier means a natural person who is an employee of a juridical person established in the territory of a Member State which has no commercial presence in the territory of the other Member State where the services will be provided, who:

Temporary residency and work permit are required for the natural persons who are contractual service suppliers. Such permits are issued for two years and may be renewed annually up to maximum of total five years.

- (i) enters the territory of that other Member State temporarily in order to supply a service pursuant to a contract(s) between his or her employer and service consumer(s) in the territory of the other Member State;
- (ii) is either an executive, manager, or specialist as defined in subparagraph e(i), e(ii) and e(iii) of Article 3 (Definitions), who receives remuneration from his or her employer;
- (iii) must possess the appropriate educational and professional qualifications relevant to the service to be provided; and
- (iv) as may be applicable, has been an employee of the juridical person for a period as may be specified in this Schedule.
