

**ASEAN AGREEMENT ON  
THE MOVEMENT OF NATURAL PERSONS**

**ANNEX 1**

**SCHEDULE OF COMMITMENTS FOR THE TEMPORARY ENTRY OR  
TEMPORARY STAY OF NATURAL PERSONS**

**THAILAND**

1. This Schedule sets out the commitments of Thailand and the general conditions and limitations governing those commitments in accordance with Article 6 (Schedules of Commitments for the Temporary Entry and Temporary Stay of Natural Persons) of the MNP Agreement in relation to the temporary entry and temporary stay of a natural person of another Member State, which apply only in relation to the categories of natural persons set out in this Schedule.
2. A natural person of a Member State shall be granted temporary entry or temporary stay in Thailand in accordance with paragraph 1 of Article 4 (Grant of Temporary Entry or Temporary Stay) of the MNP Agreement.
3. For greater certainty, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 4 (Grant of Temporary Entry or Temporary Stay) of the MNP Agreement, Thailand may deny temporary entry or temporary stay to natural persons of another Member State who do not comply with paragraphs 1(a) and 1(b) of Article 4 (Grant of Temporary Entry or Temporary Stay) of the MNP Agreement.
4. References to Central Product Classification (CPC) in this Schedule refer to the CPC codes as used in the Provisional Central Product Classification (Statistical Papers Series M No.77, Department of International Economic and Social Affairs, Statistical Office of the United Nations, New York, 1991) and Central Product Classification Version 1.1 (Statistical Papers Series M No.77, Department of International Economic and Social Affairs, Statistical Office of the United Nations, New York, 2002).
5. The use of (\*\*) against individual CPC codes indicates that the specific commitments for that code shall not extend to total range of services covered under that code.
6. Section I refers to horizontal commitments and Section II refers to sector specific commitments. An empty (blank) conditions and limitations in Section II means that the general conditions and limitations of the horizontal section, including the length of stay, shall apply and could be read as “unbound, except as indicated in Section I”.
7. The Schedules of other Member States shall not be used to interpret Thailand’s commitments or obligations under the MNP Agreement.

#### **Additional Notes for Thailand**

8. Thailand remains unbound in respect of commitments for the Temporary entry and Temporary stay of Natural Persons, except for the categories of persons set out in Section I and sectors and subsectors set out in Section II.

9. A natural person of another Member State is not allowed to purchase or own land in Thailand. *The Land Code of Thailand B.E. 2497* shall be applied to acquisition and usage of land. However, they may lease land and own buildings. Foreigners are allowed to own part of condominium units under the laws and regulations governing the ownership of condominiums.
10. A natural person of another Member State that acquires or gains ownership of land, shall be deemed ineligible to exercise rights and privileges under the MNP Agreement. A natural person who receives other special privileges or incentives from Thai authorities to supply services may not claim benefits under the MNP Agreement.
11. Temporary movement of natural persons shall not include any type or category of foreign natural persons prohibited or not allowed by *The Foreigner Working Management Emergency Decree B.E. 2560 (2017)*, as amended or by any other relevant laws or regulations<sup>1</sup>

## Reference Paper

### NOTE TO THE MARITIME TRANSPORT SCHEDULE

1. Definitions:
  - 1.1 “cabotage” : for the purpose of this schedule, means the transportation or towage of passengers or goods, between a port or place located in Thai waters and another port or place located in Thai waters.
  - 1.2 "Freight forwarding services" means the activity consisting of organizing and monitoring shipment operations on behalf of shippers, through the procurement of transport and related services, preparation of documentation and provision of business information.
  - 1.3 “Customs clearance services” means activities consisting of carrying out on behalf of another party customs formalities concerning the import, export or through transport of cargoes, whether this service is the main activities of the service supplier or a usual
  - 1.4 “Maritime cargo handling services” means activities exercised by stevedore companies, including terminal operators, but not including the direct activities of dockers when this workforce is organised independently of the stevedoring or terminal operator companies. The activities include the organisation and supervision of:
    - a. the loading/discharging of cargo to/from a ship;
    - b. the lashing/unlashing of cargo;
    - c. the reception/delivery and safekeeping of cargoes before shipment or after discharge.
  - 1.5 “Maritime agency services” means activities consisting of representing as an agent, the business interests of one or more shipping lines, for the following purposes:
    - a. marketing and sales of maritime transport and related services, from quotation to invoicing, and issuing of bill of lading of the shipping lines; procurement and resale of the necessary related services, preparation of documentation, and provision of business information;
    - b. acting on behalf of the shipping lines organizing the call of a ship or taking over cargoes when required.
