The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Southeast Asia Regional Program on Combating Marine Plastics (SEA-MaP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the consulting services for Regional Platform for Knowledge & Partnerships on Marine Plastics (Phase 2).

The objective of this consultancy is to ensure the seamless continuation of Phase 1 and readiness for transition to the hosting institution.

The consulting services ("the Services") include:

- a) Management and operation of the Regional Platform for Knowledge and Partnerships - Web platform
- b) Organisation of High-Level Policy Dialogue (HLPD), SEA-MaP Regional Workshop, and PSC Consultation (hybrid)
- c) Handover support, including preparation of handover package and support for host onboarding and operational readiness.

The assignment is expected to be completed by Q4 2026. However, this timeline is an estimate and may be subject to adjustments.

The SEA-MaP Regional Project now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers in September 2023, ("the Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

The best qualified firm to carry out the services will be selected in accordance with the Consultant's Qualifications Based Selection (CQS) method set out in the Regulations and based on the following criteria:

- Demonstrated experience, at least 3 years in building and operating a similar knowledge and partnerships platform on marine debris, circular economy, or solid waste management, preferably in the Southeast Asia/ASEAN region.
- Demonstrated availability of technical capacity and resource readiness to operationalise the forthcoming Regional Platform for Knowledge and Partnerships.
- Access to a pool of experts and/or service providers that are essential to the development and implementation of the Platform.
- Extensive experience working with ASEAN governments or inter-governmental organisations on similar assignments in the Southeast Asian region is highly preferred.
- Demonstrated experience in multi-stakeholder particularly public and private coordination and cooperation.
