JOINT PRESS STATEMENT

FIFTH ASEAN DIRECTORS-GENERAL OF IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENTS AND HEADS OF CONSULAR AFFAIRS DIVISIONS OF MINISTRIES OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS MEETING PLUS THREE CONSULTATION

25 June 2026, Siem Reap, Kingdom of Cambodia

1. The 5th DGICM + 3 Consultation was held in Siem Reap, Kingdom of Cambodia, on 25 June 2026. The Consultation was co-chaired by His Excellency Police Lieutenant General Sok Veasna, Director General of the General Department of Immigration, Ministry of Interior, Kingdom of Cambodia and Her Excellency Fukuhara Nobuko, Associate Commissioner, Immigration Services Agency of Japan. The Consultation was attended by the Heads of Immigration Departments and Heads of Consular Affairs Divisions of the Ministries of Foreign Affairs of the ASEAN Member States, People's Republic of China, Japan and the Republic of Korea, as well as representatives from the ASEAN Secretariat.
2. The Consultation exchanged views on opportunities for cooperation in the areas of immigration, consular affairs and border management within the DGICM + 3 Consultation framework. The ASEAN Member States expressed appreciation to the Plus Three countries for their continued support and assistance toward ASEAN's efforts in strengthening the capacity and capabilities of ASEAN immigration and consular authorities.
3. The Consultation discussed the implementation status of the DGICM + 3 Work Programme (2023-2027) and looked forward to its effective implementation.
4. The Consultation welcomed Indonesia's offer to host the 6th DGICM + 3 Consultation that would be held in conjunction with the 30th DGICM and Its Related Meetings in 2027 in Indonesia.
5. The Consultation extended its appreciation to the Royal Government of Cambodia and Cambodian people for the excellent arrangements made for the Consultation and the gracious hospitality extended to all delegates.

The Co-Chairs conveyed their gratitude to all delegates from the ASEAN Member States, People's Republic of China, Japan, the Republic of Korea and the ASEAN Secretariat for their commitment and valuable inputs, contributing to the successful outcome of the Consultation. The Consultation was conducted in the traditional spirit of ASEAN solidarity and cordiality.
